## DICE RUN REGISTRATION AND RULES

### PRIZES: \$1000 HIGH, \$1000 LOW

1. Thunder Valley Rally Dice Run is available to anyone 18 and older. Those who are under 21 can participate in the ride but may not engage in any gaming activities such as drawings, coupons or cash prizes. The City of Cottonwood/American Legion Riders or any organization associated with the Dice Run or events coinciding with the Dice Run do not assume any liability for any claims which may arise as a result of your participation in this event. All riders must have Current MC Endorsement, Insurance.

2. Pre-registration is through Friday, September 16, if Pre-registration by mail must arrive by September 14, Mailed to: American Legion Post 25, C/O TRV Run, 480 S Calvary Way, Cottonwood, AZ 86326, or you can also Pre-register at the American Legion Post 25, 480 S Calvary Way, Cottonwood, AZ 86326 September 15, 16 from 12 pm to 5 pm. **Pre-registration fee Rider \$20.00, Passenger \$10.00.**

3. Day-of registration takes place Saturday, September 17 at the 10-12 Lounge, 910 Main St. Clarkdale, AZ 86324. From 8:30 am to KSU 10:30 am. Registration fee **\$25.00 Rider, Passenger \$15.00**

4. This is not a timed event. No prizes will be awarded for arriving first to each venue. Riders must arrive at each stop in numerical order with the first stop being #1.

5. Participants will receive 1 ride stop card at registration. Participants roll 5 dice at each ride stop. The ride stop volunteer will add the dice roll and note it on the run card and marks the card with the stop color. **To be considered a winner you must confirm your card at the last stop by an American Legion Post 25 associate by 4:30 pm.**

6. At the end of their ride each participant must have five (5) numbers on their Ride Card and 5 colored marks. The 5 numbers the participant has rolled will be totaled up to verify High and Low Ride cards and marks will be checked.

**6A. One Extra Roll can be purchased at the last stop for \$10.00. The roll will replace one of the existing numbers to either increase or decrease your total (Best possible hands for High 150, Low 25)**

**6B. In case of a tie for either high and/or low hand the winner will be decided by a blind draw with the winning Ride Card will be drawn by the American Legion Post Commander.**

**6C. The winners will be contacted by phone and instructed to be at the Main Stage at Riverfront Park at approximately 6:00 pm and the prizes will be presented on the stage. The winners must be present to receive the winnings.**

7. Ride begins at 10:30 am 10-12 Lounge and ends at the American Legion Post 25 by 4:30 pm. Ride Cards not previously checked by a American Legion Post associate will be disqualified as of 4:45 pm.

8. This is not a race or a timed event. Be safe, observe all traffic laws and be a defensive, courteous motorist. All laws must be followed.

9. Prize money is awarded in the amount of \$1,000 for High Total and \$1,000 for Low Total. Checks will be awarded on the Riverfront Park Stage at approximately 6:15 pm.
